FROM THE DESK OF THE DIRECTOR

If there is one thing I am passionate about, it is getting our youth more engaged with our business community, and vice versa. For those of you who have perused the 2014 Members Guide, you will notice a couple of relatively new Chamber programs...simply titled Ag Tours and Business Tours. The premise behind these new programs began when I experienced the 2012 Boone Area Leadership Program class responses to the tours they took that year. What occurred to me was that if long time Boone area residents were not fully aware of the business and industry assets we have in Boone County, more than likely our high school students had no idea either. Realizing that most students leave high school with little inclination as to what they want to be "when they grow up", or what field of study they should pursue after high school, it seemed to me that getting these kids out of the high school and immersed into the backbone of our local commerce could not only show them the possibilities of their education, but light a fire in them to pursue a major, or inspire them to start their own business. Through the Ag and Business Tours, we take small groups of about thirty kids and expose them to an entrepreneur or start-up operation, show them how STEM education is applied in local research facilities, then finally bring it all home by showing them how important our local industry is, and how continuing education and trades play an important role in keeping things running smoothly. Through these tours they can leave high school with ideas on careers, and know they can come back home to work in that profession. 
